STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Christopher Kozisek, a law enforcement officer with the Stone County Sheriff's Office, knowing false statements are punishable by law, do swear, state, and affirm that I have probable cause to believe that:

Assault First Degree

The offenses occurred on or about 11/12/2025, at the [REDACTED], a location within Stone County, Missouri.

The facts supporting this are:

On 11/12/2025, Inmate [REDACTED] was viciously attacked by Inmate Seth Blevins. According to video surveillance, Inmate Blevins can be seen in Cell One pulling Inmate [REDACTED] from the top bunk and onto the floor. Shortly thereafter, Inmate Blevins took Inmate [REDACTED] mattress and property and drug it from their shared cell and deposited it into a trash can. Inmate [REDACTED] retrieved the items from the trash can and Inmate [REDACTED] and Inmate Blevins appeared to begin arguing in the day room as Inmate Blevins blocked the entrance back into their cell. Inmate [REDACTED] reached for the door handle and was violently shoved back by Inmate Blevins. Inmate [REDACTED] and Inmate Blevins then began physically fighting, with Inmate Blevins grabbing [REDACTED] and striking [REDACTED] in the face repeatedly. Inmate Blevins grabs Inmate [REDACTED] and forcibly slams Inmate [REDACTED] head into a steel housing that protrudes from the wall. Inmate Blevins continued to beat Inmate [REDACTED] and drives [REDACTED] under the stairs, out of camera view. A moment later, Inmate Blevins comes back into view without Inmate [REDACTED].

After the fight, Inmate Blevins is given several items that were identified as powdered milk by Inmate [REDACTED] and Inmate [REDACTED] says, "here ya go!"

Through the course of the investigation, it was determined that Inmate [REDACTED] refused to leave Cell One while Inmate Blevins relieved his bowels. Witnesses stated that Inmate Blevins pulled Inmate [REDACTED] off of the top bunk in the cell and onto the floor and Inmate Blevins took

Inmate [REDACTED] property and threw it in the trash can to get [REDACTED] out of the room. Witnesses said that tensions had been high between the two inmates.

I spoke with an inmate who stated that they had personally heard Inmate [REDACTED] tell Inmate Blevins that [REDACTED] would give Inmate Blevins packets of powdered milk if he beat up Inmate [REDACTED].

According to Doctors, Inmate [REDACTED] suffered severe brain trauma due to the fight. Inmate [REDACTED] brain had shifted approximately 13 millimeters inside [REDACTED] skull. Inmate [REDACTED] underwent emergency surgery to address a brain bleed and swelling. At the time of this affidavit being submitted, Inmate [REDACTED] is unconscious with no reported brain activity.

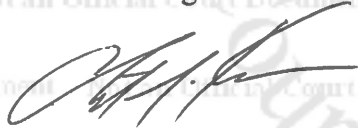
Due to the serious nature of the assault and extreme nature of the injuries, I am asking that a high bond be issued.
